The Midwestern Golf Association is an organization composed of amputees from across our region that use the game of golf as a vehicle in their physical and mental rehabilitation process. Competition in sporting events, combined with the fellowship of people in similar situations, has proven to be a wonderful incentive to help people of all ages and physical limitations achieve the best life they can enjoy.

The Midwestern Region consists of Ohio, Michigan, Illinois, Indiana, Wisconsin, Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota and Minnesota. Our goal is to get information to the rehabilitation centers and the prosthetic facilities on how to use golf in the rehabilitation process. One of the ways we do this is in cooperation with the NAGA "First Swing Program". We have a number of volunteer amputees that teach therapists how to use golf as rehabilitation for any of their physically challenged patients. In light of the amputees returning from the Iraq war, we feel this program is more important then ever.

This year, we will be hosting our 9th annual golf tournament, which is scheduled for September 11-13 at Pheasant Run Resort in St. Charles, Illinois. On September 11th, we will be hosting a scramble, which welcomes non-amputees and amputees alike. The tournament will be held September 12-13 open exclusively to amputees.
